This is the most training ever offered by the Kentucky District Royal Rangers. Use the table below to help you use your time to the best advantage of training. You cannot be in 2 places at the same time so choose wisely.

The classes below will be offered starting at 7:00 P.M. Friday evening January 21, 2011 sharp.

7:00pm. – 11:00pm. (Classes for the **New Ranger Basic** – 4 hours, second part Saturday)

This module is the foundational module that all new and present active commanders will be encouraged to attend. This is a one-day hands-on experience that teaches how to run successful outpost meetings, how to use the Rangers curriculum and advancement system, and how to build healthy relationships with boys and young men. You also learn soul-winning techniques for evangelism. The New Ranger Basics will provide commanders with all the necessary information he/she needs to effectively lead boys in a most interactive highly relational weekly meeting.

7:00pm. – 11:00pm. (**Ranger Essentials** – 4 hours, second part Saturday)

This is a one-day fun, interactive-style training event. You will learn how to connect with today's boys, along with recognizing ministry needs and outreach opportunities. You will discover how to give life-changing devotions and how to mentor boys and young men into spiritual leaders

7:00pm. – 10:00pm. (**Discipleship One** – 3 hours)

This module will provide commanders and all teachers within the church with in-depth training in soul winning counseling, and discipleship issues related to ministering to children and youth.

7:00pm. – 10:00pm. (**Safety and The Church** – 3 hours)

This module will help pastors, commanders and all teachers within the church to understand the most important safety issues in screening candidates for ministry. There will be teaching on Class room settings, safety when dealing with children and youth during class, activities, and while transporting them.

7:00pm. – 10:30pm. (**Age Specific Ranger Kids** part one – 3½ hours.)

This class is for Ranger Kids Commanders and will focus on the skills needed to safely take Ranger Kids in the outpost meeting, on outings and field trips.

7:00 – 11:00pm. (**Age Specific Expedition Rangers** – 4hrs)

This class is for Expedition Ranger Commanders and will focus on the skills needed to mentor young men into commanders of the future.

This Module addresses the benefits and values of Royal Rangers for pastors and those in church leadership.

12:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. (Class Room Management – 3 hours)

This module is for commanders and teachers within the church. The training you will receive during this module will focus upon the skills necessary to prevent and deal problems in the classroom.

12:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. (Discipleship Two – 3 hours.)

1:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m. (Age Specific Discovery/Adventure Rangers – 4 hours)

This class is for Discovery and Adventure Ranger Commanders. You will learn about the types of activities boys in Discovery Rangers and Adventure Rangers (DR/AR) can do beyond the outpost meeting and how to plan them.

3:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. (How to start an outpost – 2 hours.)

This module is for those pastors and commanders who need to know how to start Royal Rangers in their church.

3:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. (Patrol Method – 2 hours.)

This module helps commanders better understand the Patrol Method and how they can take advantage of this outstanding boy oriented leadership style outpost.

3:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. (Outpost Council – 2 hours.)

This module will equip pastors and Outpost Council members (Men Ministries) with the skills necessary to support the Royal Ranger ministry in their church.

All Certificates of completion will be issued at the end of each class in the classroom. *Trainees may leave or attend another class. Those taking only one of the classes after lunch may depart much earlier, as classes are completed.*

All day training will conclude no later than 5:00 p.m.
