

## JLDA COVID-19 GUIDELINES

- All campers and leaders must bring a mask; hand sanitizer will be available but all boys and Leaders are encouraged to bring their own individual bottles.
- Hand washing/sanitizing will be used frequently and before each meal
- Temperature checks and symptom assessments will be given daily
- Social distancing of 6' should be maintained any time possible, if it cannot be maintained masks must be worn by all parties while closer than 6'.
- Only family and boys with a signed parent/guardian waiver can stay in the same tent
- All others will be required to stay in their own tent provided by them or their outpost
- All meals will be served on paper plates with disposable utensils and cups
- Cooks will wear masks and gloves at all times while preparing and serving food
- Dining areas and classrooms will be arranged to maintain social distancing

## Daily Assessment

Once again, thank you for your patience as we navigate through the state guidelines and safeguards for COVID. For JLDA we are implementing a Health Screening assessment based on CDC recommendations.

*All Leaders must assess themselves and the boys in their outpost prior to departing for camp. Assessments will be accomplished again upon arrival at camp and at the beginning of each day to ensure that they do not have any COVID-19 symptoms.*

During each assessment each leader and boy will be asked the questions below and have their Temperature checked:

### Assessment Questions:

1. (Prior to departure to camp) Is there anyone in your household who is showing COVID-19 symptoms or who has been diagnosed with COVID-19?
2. (Prior to departure to camp) Have you been in close contact with anyone exhibiting sign or symptoms of fever, persistent cough or shortness of breath consistent with COVID-19 who has not been tested or is still awaiting testing?
3. Have you been exhibiting any of the below symptoms?
  - Cough
  - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - Fever
  - Chills
  - Muscle pain
  - Sore throat
  - New loss of taste or smell

If anyone answers '**YES**' to any of the Self-Assessment Questions prior to departure for camp unfortunately they cannot attend JLDA. If anyone answers yes once already at camp, they will maintain social distancing and report to the camp commander. Leaders will be asked to depart camp and return home. If a boy answers "yes", parents or guardians will be immediately contacted and asked to make arrangements for the boy to return home.

COVID-19 is contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact, however transmission may occur from surface to person in some cases. While rules, guidance, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist. **The Kentucky Royal Rangers cannot completely mitigate the transfer of communicable diseases like COVID-19 especially when involved in a camp or activity. Participation in a camp or activity includes possible exposure to and illness, injury, or death from infectious diseases, including COVID-19.**

In consideration for providing myself or my child the opportunity to participate in a Kentucky Royal Rangers camp or activity and any related transportation to and from camp or activity events, both my child and/or I voluntarily agree to waive and discharge any and all claims against the Kentucky Royal Rangers and release it from liability for any exposure to or illness or injury from an infectious disease including COVID-19, including claims for any negligent actions of the Kentucky Royal Rangers or its volunteers or agents, to the fullest extent allowed by law, for myself, my child, our estates, our heirs, our administrators, our executors, our assignees, and our successors.

I also agree to release, exonerate, discharge and hold harmless the Kentucky Assemblies of God, the individual members thereof, and all officers, agents, employees, volunteers, insurers and representatives from all liability, claims, causes of action, or demands, including attorney fees, fines, fees, or other costs (e.g. medical costs) arising out of any exposure to or illness or injury from an infectious disease including COVID-19, which may result from or in connection with myself or my child’s participation in a camp or extracurricular activity.

I further certify and represent that I have the legal authority to waive, discharge, release, and hold harmless the released parties on behalf of myself and/or the above-named child.

**I certify that I have read this document in its entirety and fully understand its contents. In exchange for the opportunity to participate in a Kentucky Royal Ranger’s camp or activity, the above-named child and/or I freely and voluntarily assume all risks of such hazards and notwithstanding such, release District and Assemblies of God from all liability for any loss regardless of cause, and claims arising from the campers participation in the camp or activity.**
