The Royal Ranger District Staff and I are working diligently to enhance opportunities for our boys, girls, their families, and our church leaders to grow in their relationship with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We are doing this through training camps offered to boys and leaders across the state. Speakers to visit your church to help recruit men and women into this ministry. We now offer another camp that is a great tool for such opportunities. We have entered into a co-op with the Rotary Scout Reservation in Glasgow Kentucky. This is a 239 acre camp where the Kentucky Royal Rangers, youth groups, men and women's ministries, and entire church bodies are welcome to come and camp in tents at our primitive camping area. You may want to stay in one of our nine cabins by the shower house. Or the entire group could stay in one of our two large lodges one of, which has a kitchen, and a large pavilion adjoin with a fireplace. We also have another pavilion with a large activities field and fireplace. We have a 5-acre lake for swimming and fishing. We also have canoes for the lake and a blue line creek, which also has great fishing. We also have a 4,000 square foot Activities building with a climbing wall, archery course, and a BB gun range, all indoors. We also have a shooting range for 22 rifle, black powder, and skeet shooting. We are continually developing this camp into a suitable site for Royal Rangers and any other ministry within the Assemblies of God, and other church organizations in good standing.
